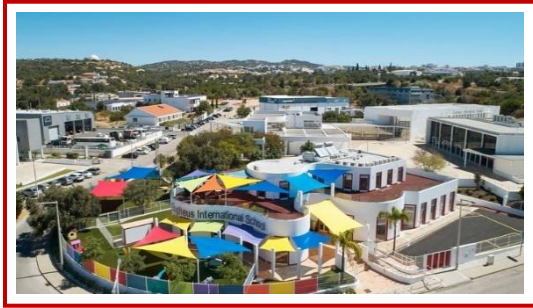

Whole School Visit to the Bombeiros Municipais de Loulé Fire Station

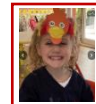
