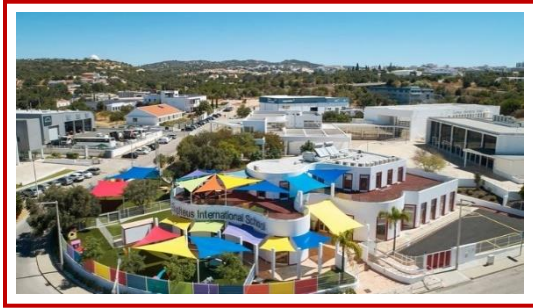




Eupheus International School – Loulé
